## Questions

1. In what ways did God speak to you during the service on Sunday?
2. Peter travelled around visiting the Lord's people. Why is this important?
3. What are the four miracles in the passage?
4. Stuart said that the salvation of a soul is the greatest miracle. Why would that be?
5. We want to see God move powerfully in and through us. Stuart mentioned Spurgeon and the quote 'Before the power comes the prayer'. Where does spending time with God and prayer fit into God moving in and through us?
6. In what ways is Tabitha an encouragement to us as followers of Jesus. Spend some time looking at some of her attributes and how God used her in His kingdom. Proverbs 31 may help you encourage each other.
7. Look at Mark 5 and see what similarities there are between the two raising of the dead accounts. Do you think Stuart is right in thinking Peter had learned how to minister in this way from Jesus?
8. What's the difference between resuscitation, re-animation, bring back from the dead – and resurrection?
9. Spend some time marvelling at the miracle of salvation and that it will ultimately lead to resurrection life for us. You may find sharing some testimonies or praise type prayer a good response to this the greatest miracle ever.
