Life Group Notes - Acts 10

Questions are based on Acts 10:1-48

- 1. This account takes place almost 10 years after Jesus tells the disciples to take the gospel into all the world. Why are we so slow to obey?
- 2. The Holy Spirit came upon the Gentiles midway through Peter's sermon.
 - a. Why do you think God did that?
 - b. Is there anything we can learn from this?
- 3. Stuart mentioned problems with Peter's heart, problems with Cornelius' heart and problems with our hearts.
 - a. What was Peter struggling with?
 - b. What was wrong with Cornelius' heart? (Cornelius was God fearing, prayerful, generous financially and yet he wasn't saved).
 - c. What does this passage highlight could be problems with our hearts? (our attitude to other nations, prejudice, racism, class, etc)
- 4. Stuart said that we are all a little weird.
 - a. Does that offend you? (he did include himself 💿)
 - b. He also mentioned 'no perfect people allowed' and 'everybody is normal until you get to know them'. How do these phrases affect the way we behave as a community?
 - c. Where does discipleship and leadership fit into the welcoming of 'all types of people'?
- 5. What did you feel when you opened the envelope? (You are invited. Love, Jesus)
- 6. Try to explain why the Gospel is good news to all nations.
- 7. Did God challenge you on anything personally on Sunday morning?
